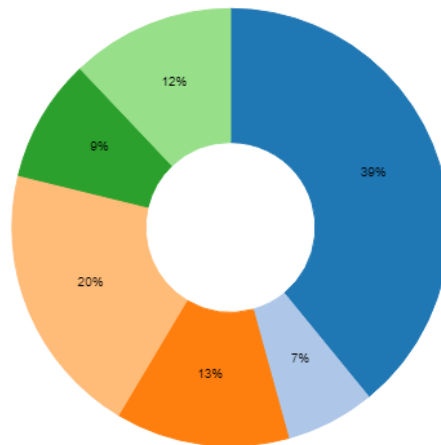




### 2019 Stats

The Vegreville Food Bank started to use a more accurate data base for tracking client visits as of January 1<sup>st</sup> 2019. It will give us a clearer picture of our usage in the years to come.

● 0-18 Years (301)    ● 19-24 Years (51)    ● 25-35 Years (99)  
● 36-50 Years (156)    ● 51-59 Years (70)    ● 60+ Years (93)



Consistent with previous years, our 2019 stats show that the majority of those helped by the Vegreville Food Bank are children and youths. In 2019 770 individuals were served from 314 households. Of the 770 individuals 301 from 126 households were between 0-18 years old. Regular hampers may be received every two months for those with children, and every three months for those without.

The timeline below graphs usage monthly over 2019. The spike in new clients at the beginning of the year reflects that all clients were considered new in the new data base.

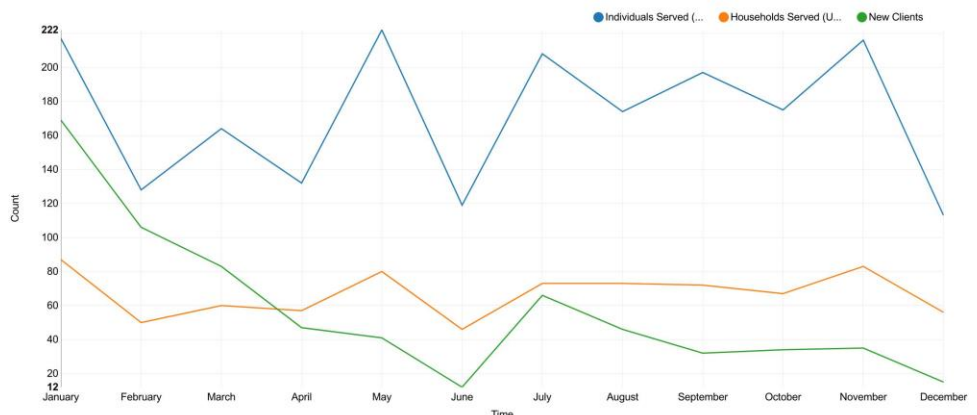
