

2021 Stats




In 2021, more than one third of those helped by the Vegreville Food Bank were children and youths.

In 2021 we gave out 569 hampers, 436 of those being regular hampers, and 133 were emergency hampers.

The timeline below graphs usage monthly over 2021. Over August and September of 2021, there was a large increase in new clients (green line), due to inflation. It also shows an increase in households served in October, raising our average from about 45 to about 60 households per month.
